

Application for Sutter Lego Show

All submissions should be made in good taste and will be returned **APPROVED** by the Sutter Lego Show Committee. Once the application is returned approved, the project has been accepted into the Show and the student will be responsible for making the necessary preparations to have their project ready for display on the night of the Show. Project proposals **MUST BE FILLED OUT** and will include details about the project such as: approximate size, if it includes minifigures and how many, the student's reason for choosing subject matter, and why the student's project would be a great addition to the show. Limit one application entry per student. Group projects are allowed but will count as the student's single entry. **NO store bought kits should be submitted as original work** (but may be used as part of a larger original creation that is modified to showcase originality and ingenuity). ***The Sutter Lego Show is a component of the Sutter PTA STEAM Initiative***

Application Deadline is Monday, December 17th, 2018

Category Descriptions:

ARCHITECTURE – Any model constructed to represent any number of different types of structures. May include but not limited to: firehouses, bank, secret base, castle fortress, police station, movie studio, school, department store, amusement park, coffee shop, toy store, etc...

MOSAIC – A picture, design or pattern created from tiles

CREATURES – A model in this category would include any living creature. May include but not limited to: lion, octopus, spider, giraffe, etc... May also include fantasy creatures such as aliens, dragons, etc....

VEHICLE – Any model constructed to represent any number of types of vehicles. May include but not limited to: airplanes, cars, spaceships, trucks, boats, rockets, gliders, submarines, etc....

SCENE/DIARAMA – Scenes may include but not limited to: historical event, science fiction, medieval, fantasy, cityscape, landscapes, etc... This category may be used to incorporate a student's minifigure collection to depict a scene.

Deep 6 – Any creation reflecting the mystery of the ocean or any body of water. May include but not limited to: lake scene, underwater exploration, experimental ocean discovery vehicle, aquatic life, a nautical legend or person, etc....

Stand-alone store bought kits are NOT PERMITTED on their own; you must use your own imagination to create scenes or action sequences involving the kit in order to include it. Example may be an Avenger Quinjet being attacked by hydra agents with multiple additional elements that the student creates from scratch to complete that scene.
